## **Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting**

Dr Arif Shaikh – Director, KLS IMER, Belagavi welcomed the members of BOS and made opening remarks and briefed about the agenda of the meeting.

### **1. To read and confirm the minutes of the last meeting held on 20.10.2023 and 17.04.2023**

Presented the compliance report of the minutes of the Academic Council meeting held on 20.10.2023 and Special Academic Council meeting held on 17.04.2023. The members applauded the efforts of the institute in complying with all the points raised during the past meeting. The compliance report was approved by the Academic Council.

### **2. To consider the changes in the course contents of MBA 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester syllabus as approved by the BoS**

The changes with regards to the course contents with the following subjects was presented to the Academic Council

- a. Statistics for Managers: Change in the number of hours in the course contents
- b. Business Research Methods: Change in the number of hours in the course contents
- c. Corporate Evaluation: Change in the number of hours in the course contents
- d. Learning and Development: Updating the latest information on learning and development as per the needs of the students and changes in the industry.
- e. Organizational Behavior: Suggested changes in the selection case studies for the course.
- f. Change of nomenclature for the specialization information technology to Business Analytics

**The Academic Council discussed the changes at length and accorded its approval**

### **3. To consider proposal for introduction of certification courses and its contents as approved by the BoS**

Introduction of certification courses was presented in the BoS meeting dated 23.09.2023, the same was approved by BoS. The matter was placed before Academic Council for consideration and directions for implementation of the courses to up-skill the students with latest trends in the industry.
